

Poly Stone™ Back Coats & Back Fills



The following is to assist in selecting the correct pigment for matrix behind Poly Stone. *If you do not see a Poly Stone color referenced, this means that a natural, unpigmented backfill may be used.* Custom colors will require your experimentation to determine for yourself which matrix color works best with your custom Poly Stone spray granite color. Light color pigment loading should be at 0.5%, medium color pigment loading at 1.0% and dark, bold color loadings at 1.5% to 2.0%. The following table will serve as a guideline to selection of the proper matrix color. The following color recommendations are based on BROCOM® colors. Other brands may be used. An alternative to pigmented back fills is to pigment resin and create a pigmented back coat before back filling.

For the new Poly Stone colors released in 2006 that are not listed above, no pigment color was used in the back fill when creating the colors. Examples include Coriander and Tapioca. Contact our laboratory for more information on our recommended backfill colors.

Ultimately, there are **two reasons to pigment a backfill.**

1. Hide thin areas from spraying.
2. Make the granite coating less obvious (in regards to its thickness).
